- Wando is a test center. (listed under Mount Pleasant). Make sure you correctly enter the test center code:

- Wando's school code: 411-445
- **Make sure you enter in the colleges where you would like your test scores to be sent when you register for the test.**



- **Fee Waivers** are available for the ACT, SAT and college applications if you are on the free or reduced lunch program. See your counselor in Guidance for fee waivers.
- ACT and SAT allow two test fee waivers each.
- NCAA Clearinghouse allows a fee waiver if you have already received a waiver for the ACT or SAT.

****Admiral James B. Osborn Memorial Scholarship -**

Eligible students for this \$500 and up scholarship must live in the Tri-county area and have a family member who is a submarine qualified individual who is a member of the US Submarine Veterans Inc. See Ms. Beaver for application.

Deadline: April 15th.

****Air Force Association**—students who are dependents of an enlisted active duty or retired Air Force Airman (or Guard or Reserve) who is majoring in a science, technology, engineering, or math program in college are eligible. \$2,500 for tuition. Go to www.afa.org/aef/aid/ferretti.asp.

****Angel Dolphin Scholarship**—\$500 for students who have lost one or both parents and are attending a 4-year college in the fall. Min. GPA— 2.7. Min SAT— 1100. Go to www.angeldolphinsscholarship.org. **Deadline: March 21st.**

Archibald Rutledge Scholarship - Students with interest in creative writing, visual arts, music, dance, and/or theater and who are attending a SC institution next year are eligible for this \$2,000 scholarship. See Ms. Beaver for details.

Deadline: Feb. 3rd.

BigSun Scholarship -Student athletes are eligible for this \$500 award. Visit www.bigsunathletics.com to apply.

Deadline: June 22nd.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Military Children Program Scholarship - any senior planning to attend a 4 year college or 2 year transfer program who is a dependent of a service member (active duty, reservist, guardsman, retiree) is eligible to apply for this \$1,500 scholarship. Go to www.militaryscholar.org. **Deadline: Feb. 24th.**

University of Michigan Geisinger Scholarship - \$20,000/yr for non-Michigan residents majoring in engineering should apply. Visit www.engin.umich.edu/students/scholarships for more information.

Navy/Nurse ROTC Scholarships - Visit www.navy.com/careers/nrotc for more information.

Nina Neely Scholarship - Any graduating senior is eligible. This essay contest awards \$1,000 to 1st place, \$600 to 2nd place, and \$400 to 3rd place. Essay topic: "Has technology helped or harmed the world?" See Ms. Beaver for an application. **Deadline: March 13th.**

****Rotary Club of Mt. Pleasant Scholarship** - students must be a resident of the East Cooper area, must have a GPA of 2.75 or higher, and must demonstrate community service. Award of up to \$1,000. See Ms. Beaver for an application. **Deadline: March 30th.**

US Department of Agriculture National Scholars Program - Students who plan on attending one of 1890 Historically Black Land-Grant Universities and who plan to major in agriculture, food, or natural resource sciences are encouraged to apply. For details, visit www.usda.gov/1890program.xml.

****Silver Wings Scholastic Assistance Award**—Eligible students must be a dependent of an Active or Reserve Duty, retired or deceased Military personnel. Students must also be a current military ID holder. See Ms. Beaver for application. **Deadline: March 1st.**

****SC Coaches Association of Women's Sports and Trophies: "M" Medical Scholarship and Sport Educators Scholarship** - See Ms. Beaver if you are planning to major in the medical field or education. Only one female can be nominated for each scholarship. **Deadline: March 15th.**

****SC Education Association of Retired Educators-** for students planning to pursue an education major at a SC institution. Must need financial aid and demonstrate leadership abilities. See Ms. Beaver. **Deadline: March 15th.**

****SC Federal Credit Union**—3 scholarships: \$4,000/\$2,500/\$1,000. Go to www.youngfreesc.com to apply. **Deadline: March 15th.**

SC Law Enforcement Officers' Foundation Scholarship - This essay contest offers one \$5,000 and two \$2,000 scholarships to students who plan to attend a SC college. To apply, go to www.scleo.org/scholarship. **Deadline February 10th.**

****SC Society of the Sons of the American Revolution** - applicants do not have to be related to members of the Sons of the American Revolution. See Ms. Beaver for an application. **Deadline: Feb. 28th.**

****SC State University Alumni Association** - students planning to attend SC State University should see Ms. Beaver for scholarship opportunities. **Deadline: March 15th.**

****Society of American Military Engineers** - students must be a member or child of a member of the Charleston Post or member of the Citadel Student Chapter of SAME. GPA—3.0 or higher on 4.0 scale. Must be accepted in a 4-year college to major in engineering, architecture, science, math, or a related field of study. See Ms. Beaver. **Deadline: April 13th.**
